SCC Members present: Michael Day [chair], Stephen Stepenuck [vice chair, arrived at 4:19] Deb Crowder, Jane Johnson, Bob Goodrich, Mike Morrison [arrived at 4:12].

1. Guest: Tom Duston from Chesterfield CC and Reeve Gutsell: Update about trail from West Hill trails in Keene to Pisgah State Park. Ms. Gutsell updated the SCC on the proposed trail that follows various logging trails as well as an under 1 mile new proposed trail. Mr. Duston spoke about the gates in the area of Colony Pond in Chesterfield.
