CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Deborah J. Davis at 9:05 a.m. Present were Deborah J. Davis, Kenneth P. Colby, Jr., and W. William Hutwelker III. Also present was Town Administrator Michael Branley.

Motion was made by Colby to enter nonpublic session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3 II (a), seconded by Hutwelker. All in favor by Roll Call and the ***motion passed***. The Board entered nonpublic session at 9:05 a.m.

The Board returned from nonpublic session at 9:20 a.m.

Motion was made by Hutwelker to seal the minutes because divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a member of this board, seconded by Colby. All in favor and the ***motion passed***.

Colby stated he met with the Lafonds regarding their proposed donation of a flagpole for the West Swanzey riverside park. A solar powered light to keep the flag illuminated was discussed. The Board agreed by consensus to accept the donation and to have the Department of Public Works install the flagpole. A proposed plaque was discussed recognizing the site as the former home of the West Swanzey Athletic Association. The Board agreed by consensus to allow the installation of the plaque.

Motion was made by Colby to seal the minutes because divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a member of this board, seconded by Hutwelker. All in favor and the ***motion passed***.

The Board directed Branley to post the job opportunity for part-time recreation director.
