

## **Permit to Install and Operate Oil Burning Equipment**

A permit to install and operate oil burning equipment is required prior to installation of oil burning equipment in accordance with RSA 153:5, State Fire Code SAF 6012.3 and NFPA standard # 31 Standard for the installation of Oil-Burning Equipment 2006 Edition.

Saf-C6012.02 Compliance Required:

- (a) All persons installing, causing to be installed or modifying, repairing or maintaining oil burning equipment shall comply with the requirements of NFPA 31 as adopted by Saf-C6012

### **Procedure to obtain a permit**

- Applications to obtain a permit to install and operate oil burning equipment may be obtained at the Swanzey Fire Headquarters, 34 Main Street, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 08:00am and 4:00pm or by calling 358-6455 and leaving a voice mail with your name, address and telephone number.
- Oil burner permits may be obtained by the property owner or by an individual who is installing oil burning equipment on behalf of a property owner.
- Permit Applications require the following information for processing:
  - Address of installation
  - Type of Occupancy
  - Owners Name
  - Owners Address
  - Occupants Name
  - Make and Serial Number of the Oil Burner
  - Size and location of the oil storage tank
  - Name of the Installer:
    - Business Name
    - Address of Installer
    - Telephone Number of the installer
  - Date
  - Signature of the Owner or Installer
  - Signature of the Fire Chief or Designee
- Once issued the property owner and or installer may install and operate the oil burning equipment described in the application until such time as the installation has been inspected by the Fire Chief or designee
- A fee of \$ 50.00 is required for an application to install oil burning equipment.
