


Q1 How long have you lived in Swanzeey (or if you are not a resident, how long have you owned property here?)



Q2 Which age range best describes you?



Q3 Do you have children under the age of 18 years old who live with you?



Q4 Select all of the following that describe you



Q5 How did you vote on the \$4.5 million bond in 2015 (fire station)?













Q11 If you did not vote in the 2016 March Town Elections, please select the reason(s) you did not vote



Q12 How do you feel that the town did in providing information that you needed to make an informed decision regarding the 2016 \$5.5 million bond proposal?



Q13 What is your preferred way to receive information from the town about town projects (1 being the most preferred, 7 being the least preferred)?


