
Thomas Hubka's Big House, Little House, Back House, Barn: The Connected Farm Buildings of New England

"Big house, little house, back house, barn"--this rhythmic cadence was sung by nineteenth-century children as they played. It also portrays the four essential components of the farms where many of them lived.

Through architecture unique to northern New England, this illustrated talk focuses on several case studies that show how farmers converted their typical separate house and barns into connected farmsteads.

A visual delight as well as an engaging tribute to our nineteenth-century forebears, Mr. Hubka's book has become one of the standard works on regional farmsteads in America.
