The Swanze Conservation Commission met on May 7, 2012 at the Swanze Town Hall. Those present were:

Deb Crowder, chairperson, and Bob Goodrich, Gary Coburn, Ric Dell'Erba Stephen Stepenuck and Jane Johnson.

The meeting was called to order at 4:20 p.m. The members reviewed the Swanze Roadside Cleanup of April, 28, 2012. An estimated 30 persons participated. A discussion of ideas related to state fines for littering on state highways in Swanze followed and included the possibility of promoting a littering/dumping fine (signage posted) for Swanze town roads. Deb Crowder will check for ordinances in other towns to garner ideas for action on this matter.

On April 16, 2012 Deb Crowder and Ric Dell'Erba attended a site walk and site plan review at a ZBA meeting. They reported that two wetland areas near the sight are not significantly impacted by the proposed project at 544 Monadnock Hwy. (Rte 12) Nissan Dealership, and are being mitigated with retention pond. The planned expansion was approved by the ZBA.

Mike Morrison has reported that two youngsters are interested in applying to the NHF&G/UNH Extension Service-sponsored conservation camp programs. They have been directed to the website. The application requires a \$150 deposit upon registration which the families will pay. SCC will pay the remainder of the fee for two applicants. They would attend the Barry Conservation Camp Summer Program.

Stephen Stepenuck and Ric Dell'Erba attended a Saving Special Places workshop. They gave a brief overview of that event and Ric has since posted a sign for the Loop Trailhead on the Mt. Cresson Trail.

There was a discussion of an email from Ann Shedd of Keene, regarding cutting to be done in an area of Keene Airport property which would infringe on a rare peat bog north of the north runway. KCC has met with the airport director, Ed Mattern. Deb Crowder suggested we send a letter to Mr. Mattern. Jane Johnson moved the letter be written and sent, Bob Goodrich seconded the motion. A 'yea' vote was unanimous. Deb Crowder volunteered to write the letter.

Non-compliance (violation)NHDES by Thomas Bouffard, 81 Wilson Pond Rd., regarding a gazebo within setback was discussed. The porch that was within the violation has been removed as of 4/24.

A Wetlands Permit has been received for the California Brook Bridge on Cobble Hill-4/20/12.

Steve Stepenuck mentioned the Ashuelot River Monitoring Training session to be held at KSC, May 8, 6:30-8:30 p.m.

Deb Crowder, for the Open Space Committee, reported that they are currently sponsoring a Flat Ike project and will display the resulting information at the MRHS learning fair on May 15. This project is to promote interest in outdoor activities locally. The OSC is also making plans for participation in the 2012 Swanzey Old Home Day in July and is working on trailmaking on the Tolman Trail. She also reported work with Land For Good in relation to possible conservation of some of the "Brown Farm".

A number of future workshops were discussed and details noted in the agenda. After some discussion, a motion was made by Deb Crowder and seconded by Jane Johnson that SCC members and interested citizens join to help in the annual River Cleanup this year instead of sponsoring a SCC Canoe Trip. The votes were 4 yea and 1 abstention.

The minutes of February, March and April meetings were approved unanimously.

Other concerns discussed were the removal of Upper Wilson Pond from Shoreland Consolidated List of Water Bodies and the BOS Rules of Procedure-newly adopted amendments.

It was noted that we have not honored Michael Day upon his retirement from SCC. Deb Crowder volunteered to have a plaque created and we spoke of naming a date for honoring him. This will be decided upon later.

Jane Johnson moved we adjourn, Gary Coburn seconded the motion. All were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6 p.m.
