### Items Discussed:

- Flat Ike Project
  - Ryan sent out invitations to everyone including town officials for Learning Fair
  - MC hired a photographer to photograph them for MC use and ours.
  - Learning Fair set up is 2:30 pm at MRHS
  - Sharon has 14" digital frame to be used at town hall

  - We will have table, easel, and buttons at Learning Fair – Tuesday 5-7:30, Paula will help set up at 2:30. Sharon will be there early, Bev will be there at 5pm. We will wear our buttons and our name tags. Jeanne will get name tags from Sara.
  - Judy is making arrows for the hallways.
  - Jeanne will drop off posters to Deb at the high school Tuesday morning
  - Ike's visit to children is 6/13/12 – time not scheduled yet, might be lunch time, at MRHS. Bob will help out.
  - Get Flat Ikes to teachers ahead of time to distribute to kids – Sharon will take care of getting them to teachers.
